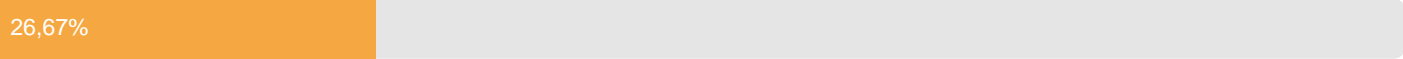

Changes Verification of Tax Declarations	The role of the tax professional would evolve more towards supervising automated systems and intervening in case of exceptions or anomalies.
Future-proof Skills ↑	
Knowledge of Strategic Implications of Tax	With a focus on CSR, transparency, and eco-taxation, the advisory and strategic role of the tax professional is crucial. These aspects require nuanced understanding and expertise that cannot be automated.
Promotion of a Legal and Tax Culture within the Company	Education, awareness, and implementing a strong tax culture within the company require human skills, interactions, and training that AI cannot replace.

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
